EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR

TRANSFERRING THE CENSUS FUNCTIONS OF THE STATE DATA RESEARCH CENTER AT THE BOARD OF REGENTS TO THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND BUDGET

WHEREAS: the functions to analyze census data were transferred from the Office of Planning and Budget to a new State Data Research Center in the FY 1997 budget; and

WHEREAS: Georgia state government should have an efficient and effective governance structure with one point of for census data analysis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY:

ORDERED: That effective February 1, 2003 that the functions, necessary equipment, \$2,850 for operating expenses, \$103,333 for salaries and benefits for the last 3 months of FY 2003 for 4 positions for census data analysis be transferred back to the Office of Planning and Budget.
