EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS:

Baker County Sheriff Isaac Anderson has been

indicted for multiple federal felonies, <u>United States</u> v. Isaac Anderson, Crim. No. 1:03-CR-13-2-WLS

(M.D. Ga. Filed May 9, 2003); and,

WHEREAS:

The District Attorney for the South Georgia Judicial

Circuit, The Honorable J. Brown Moseley,

transmitted a certified copy of the indictment to the Office of the Governor under O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6-(b), which copy was received on May 19, 2003;

and,

WHEREAS:

The 14-day period following receipt of the

indictment prescribed by O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6-(e) has

run.

I therefore appoint Attorney General Thurbert Baker, Chatham County Sheriff Al St. Lawrence, and Thomas County Sheriff Carlton Powell as the review commission to determine whether the indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of the office of Sheriff held by Mr. Anderson and whether the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby and to make a written report to me within 14 days with a recommendation as to whether Mr. Anderson should be suspended from office as required by O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6-(c).
