EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: Allyson Romedy disappeared approximately one year ago.

WHEREAS: Shortly after she was reported missing, her car was found in an apartment

complex. After which time, a massive search was undertaken, including

the involvement of several Emergency Management entities.

WHEREAS: The whereabouts of Allyson Romedy have still not been determined, and

no arrests have been made in connection with her disappearance.

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that

The Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in

the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN

ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for

information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of

person or persons responsible for the disappearance of Allyson Romedy.
