## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** On June 16, 2003, Ms. Verdell Moore was reported missing, and the Emanuel County Sheriff's Department suspects that foul play might have been involved.

**WHEREAS:** The Emanuel County Sheriff's Department and the Georgia Bureau of Investigation conducted various searches, interviews, interrogations, and polygraph tests, and have been unable to identify any suspects in connection with the disappearance of Ms. Moore.

**WHEREAS:** Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that The Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of Georgia.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the disappearance of Ms. Verdell Moore
