EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On June 7

On June 7, 1995, Nicole Smith, an eighth-grade Atlanta middle school student, was on her way to school when an unidentified assailant sexually

assaulted and fatally shot her; and

WHEREAS: Through DNA analysis, the Georgia Bureau of Investigation has linked

Nicole Smith's assailant to the recent rape of a thirteen-year-old East Point

girl; and

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated provides that the

Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction

of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of

Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN

ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$5,000.00 is hereby offered for information

leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the 1995 murder of Nicole Smith and the recent rape

of a thirteen-year-old East Point girl.
