EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On June 29, 2005 at 7:17 PM, Dinesh Shah was shot to death while working at the Ramada In, located at 3403 Memorial Drive.

WHEREAS Dekalb County Police Department has been unable to generate any solid information leading to the identification or apprehension of a suspect;

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the individual/s responsible for the murder of Dinesh Shah.
