EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The General Assembly passed House Bill 298 during the 2005 Legislative Session that changed the assignment for administrative purposes only of the Georgia Medical Center Authority from the Department of Community Affairs to the Department of Economic Development.


The General Assembly passed House Bill 85, the Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2006, during the 2005 Legislative Session that appropriated \$250,000 in state general funds to the Georgia Medical Center Authority.

In House Bill 85 the appropriations for the Georgia Medical Center Authority are contained within the budget unit: Department of Community Affairs.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That, as of July 1, 2005, the Georgia Medical Center Authority and \$250,000 in state general funds be transferred to the Department of Economic Development from the Department of Community Affairs.
