EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On February 4, 2006, the body of Justin Wills was found after being abandoned on a county road in Oglethorpe County; and


WHEREAS: The Oglethorpe County Sheriff's Office has conducted an investigation and has been unable to generate any solid leads; and

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of a person who has committed a felony.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, arrest and conviction of the individual/s responsible for unlawfully concealing the death of Mr. Justin Wills.
