BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS:

The Department of Natural Resources has requested

permission to demolish a storm damaged barn at Fort Yargo

State Park in Barrow County; and

WHEREAS:

Said structure has been declared by the Commissioner of the

Department of Natural Resources to be unserviceable and of

no value to the Department; and

WHEREAS:

The Historic Preservation Division has determined that this

structure is not eligible for inclusion in the Georgia or

National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS:

The Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources

has requested that said structure be demolished as soon as

possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF

THE STATE OF GEORGIA BY VIRTUE OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF

GEORGIA, ANNOTATED 50-16-14, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED:

That the Department of Natural Resources is hereby

authorized and directed to provide for the demolition and disposal of aforesaid structure under terms and conditions

that are in the best interest of the State of Georgia.
