



THE STATE OF GEORGIA

EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia owns fifteen (15) parcels of real property, the custody of thirteen (13) being in Department of Education (hereinafter "DOE"), located throughout the State of Georgia upon which is situated broadcast transmission equipment of various types, including transmission towers, (hereinafter "Sites"), the Sites being more particularly described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated by this reference; and
- WHEREAS:** DOE cannot advantageously or beneficially use the Sites that are within its custody in the performance of its statutory duties; and
- WHEREAS:** All of the Sites are currently under the care and control of the Georgia Public Telecommunications Commission (hereinafter "GPTC"); and
- WHEREAS:** GPTC is authorized and empowered to hold licenses issued by the Federal Communications Commission ("hereinafter "FCC") or other appropriate governmental agencies necessary for the operation of public telecommunications facilities and to operate such facilities in the State of Georgia for the purpose of serving the educational and public telecommunications needs of the state and the various communities within the state; and
- WHEREAS:** Control of the Sites is critical to the mission of the GPTC; and
- WHEREAS:** In the 2003 Amended Appropriations, the General Assembly authorized the sale of General Obligation Bonds for the purpose of bringing the Sites into compliance with FCC mandated digital requirements; and
- WHEREAS:** The Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, (hereinafter "Board of Regents") identified as the user agency of the bond proceeds, has agreed to hold title to the towers and engage GPTC to operate, care and control the Sites and assure the proper application of the bond proceeds; and


WHEREAS: At its March 3, 2005 meeting, DOE agreed to relinquish custody of the real property to the Board of Regents; and

WHEREAS: At its March 8, 2006 meeting, Regents agreed to accept title to all fifteen (15) of the real and the personal property and fixtures relating to the Sites.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That title to the Sites, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A", be and the same is hereby transferred from the State of Georgia to the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia.
