EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exists at the Valdosta State University, Lowndes County, Valdosta, Georgia, buildings known as Hopper Hall and Georgia Hall (the "Buildings"); and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents at its meeting on April 18, 2007, declared by resolution that said Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by Valdosta State University or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed; and

WHEREAS: It is the opinion of Ms. Linda M. Daniels, Vice Chancellor for Facilities of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that the Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by Valdosta State University or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Buildings from Valdosta State University, Lowndes County, Valdosta, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of Valdosta State University, Lowndes County, Valdosta, Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
