EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On Friday, May 4, 2007, Mr. Jefferson "Jeff" I. Davis, III, a.k.a. "Sugar Bear," and two fellow passengers perished in a plane crash near Asheville, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS: Jeff Davis was committed to his community and to his fellow man, serving in leadership roles for the Rotary Club of Dublin, the Free and Accepted Masons, and the Boy Scouts of America, to name only a few; and

WHEREAS: In the hearts of those who knew him, Jeff Davis will always be remembered for his loyalty, his sense of humor, and his love of life; and

WHEREAS: His life is an example of Christ's commandment, "That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have loved one to another." John 13:34-35.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF JEFFERSON I. DAVIS, III, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flags be flown at half-staff on the Governor's Mansion and grounds on Wednesday, May 9, 2007, the day of his interment, until sunset.
