EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The General Assembly passed Senate Bill 85 during the 2009 Legislative Session, which created the Georgia Aviation Authority, attached for administrative purposes to the Department of Administrative Services. The Georgia Aviation Authority is created by consolidating the current aviation programs and various responsibilities from the Department of Transportation, Department of Natural Resources, Department of Public Safety and the Georgia Forestry Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That, as of July 1, 2009, the Department of Transportation will transfer \$657,795 in other funds and \$1,695,877 of proceeds from the sale of two aircrafts, 25 positions, 2 motor vehicles, 7 aircrafts and associated equipment to the Georgia Aviation Authority.

ORDERED: As of July 1, 2009, the Department of Natural Resources will transfer \$828,600 in state general funds, \$100,000 in other funds, 4 positions, 2 motor vehicle, 4 aircrafts and associated equipment to the Georgia Aviation Authority.

ORDERED: As of July 1, 2009, the Department of Public Safety will transfer \$1,269,277 in state general funds, 6 positions, 19 aircrafts and associated equipment to the Georgia Aviation Authority.

ORDERED: As of July 1, 2009, the Georgia Forestry Commission will transfer \$1,607,432 in state general funds, 24 positions, 3 motor vehicles, 24 aircrafts and associated equipment to the Georgia Aviation Authority.
