EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The Governor's Office of Consumer Affairs administers and enforces the Fair Business Practices Act of 1975, which was enacted to protect consumers from unfair, deceptive and illegal practices in the consumer marketplace; and

WHEREAS: Public awareness of this agency's consumer protection function is essential; and

WHEREAS: The name "Governor's Office of Consumer Affairs" does not adequately inform the public of the agency's consumer protection responsibilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Governor's Office of Consumer Affairs henceforth may also be referred to and known as "The Governor's Office of Consumer Protection."
