EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exist at North Georgia College & State University, Lumpkin County, Dahlonega, Georgia, buildings known as Sirmons Hall (#23), Chow Dining Hall (#10), Woodward Infirmary (#33) (the "Buildings"); and

WHEREAS: The Board of Regents at its meeting on October 13, 2010, declared by resolution that said Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by the Georgia Institute of Technology or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed; and

WHEREAS: It is the opinion of Ms. Linda M. Daniels, Vice Chancellor for Facilities of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that the Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by the North Georgia College & State University or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Buildings from the North Georgia College & State University, Lumpkin County, Dahlonega, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of the North Georgia College & State University, Lumpkin County, Dahlonega, Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
