EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: Hurricane Ike severely disrupted motor fuel supplies to the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: I issued a State of Emergency on September 12, 2008, due to the energy emergency caused by Hurricane Ike's impact on the motor fuel supplies to the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: I renewed the State of Emergency on October 10, 2008; and

WHEREAS: The motor fuel supply disruptions experienced as a result of Hurricane Ike have been mitigated such that a State of Emergency is no longer warranted.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the State of Emergency declared on September 12, 2008, and renewed on October 10, 2008, is terminated.
