

THE STATE OF GEORGIA

EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: There currently exists at the University of Georgia, Athens, Clarke County, Georgia, a building known as 294 South Lumpkin Street (Building #4858), (the "Building"); and

WHEREAS: At its June 2008 meeting, the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia (the "Board"), authorized the Chancellor to take action on behalf of the Board of Regents between the June 2008 and August 2008 meeting; and

WHEREAS: On behalf of the Board, Erroll B. Davis, Jr., Chancellor of the Board of Regents, declared by resolution that said Building can no longer be advantageously used by the University of Georgia or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed; and

WHEREAS: It is the opinion of Ms. Linda M. Daniels, Vice Chancellor for Facilities of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that the Building can no longer be advantageously used by Gordon College, or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Building from the University of Georgia, Athens, Clarke County, Georgia.

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That the appropriate staff of the University of Georgia, Athens, Clarke County, Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises by public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
