



THE STATE OF GEORGIA

EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 5,957 acres in the City of Reidsville, Tattnall County which includes that facility known as the Georgia State Prison (the "Property"), as described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and
- WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Department of Corrections; and
- WHEREAS:** Old buildings L & M located on the Property (the "Structures"), as described in Exhibit B, were found to be more expensive to correct to current penal construction standards and operation than their inherent worth, and were declared unserviceable and abandoned in their entirety in February 2007; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Board of Corrections on August 5, 2010, resolved that it has no plans to use the Structures for any future purpose, and requested that the State Properties Commission seek an Executive Order from the Governor to allow for the razing, demolition, and disposal of the Structures as in the best interest of the State of Georgia; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Department of Corrections has funding available to raze and demolish and dispose of said Structures.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** The Georgia Department of Corrections is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition and disposal of said Structures under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interests of the State of Georgia.


