EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: Attorneys for Brian Nichols have filed a complaint against the Georgia Public Defender Standards Council, the Honorable James Bodiford, and others, in a lawsuit styled *Brian Nichols v. Georgia Public Defender Standards Council*, et al., Civil Action Case No. 2008CV148277, Superior Court of Fulton County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS: The Attorney General, because of a conflict, has declined representation of Judge Bodiford in this case; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Charles Clay of the firm Brock Clay Calhoun & Rogers PC, has agreed to represent the Honorable James Bodiford in this matter at a rate mutually agreed upon to by Judge Bodiford and Mr. Clay.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO O.C.G.A. § 45-15-70 AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Mr. Charles Clay of the firm Brock Clay Calhoun & Rogers PC is hereby appointed as Special Counsel to assume control and responsibility for the representation of the Honorable James Bodiford in all matters related to *Brian Nichols v. Georgia Public Defender Standards Council*, et al., Civil Action Case No. 2008CV148277.
