## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** On January 5, 2010, I issued a State of Emergency due to a continued period of extremely cold weather which increased the demand for fuel oil, diesel oil, gasoline, kerosene, propane, and liquid petroleum gas to residential and commercial establishments; and

**WHEREAS:** The extreme cold temperatures which originally increased the demand for and threatened the uninterrupted delivery of the above referenced fuels have subsided such that a State of Emergency is no longer warranted.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That the State of Emergency declared on January 5, 2010, is terminated effective 8:00 a.m. on January 21, 2010.
