EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 3.03 acres known as the Albany DOAS tower property, and the Georgia Department of Administrative Services is the custodian of said property in Dougherty County; and
- WHEREAS:** Said property containing approximately 3.03 acres is described in Exhibit A (the premises) at 1700 Radium Springs Avenue, as found in the Quit Claim deed of June 21, 1971, from the Board of Commissioners of Dougherty County Georgia to the State of Georgia, and which includes a building and a telecommunications tower; and
- WHEREAS:** On May 7, 1992, custody of the premises was transferred by Executive Order from the Georgia Department of Public Safety to the Georgia Department of Administrative Services, and the Georgia Technology Authority had been occupying the premises as a telecommunications regional office including a telecommunications tower; and
- WHEREAS:** On April 8, 2009, the Commissioner of the Georgia Department of Administrative Services determined that neither the agency nor Georgia Technology Authority will at any time in the future need use of the premises for any other purposes; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Department of Natural Resources is desirous of using the above-described premises including the tower and building located thereon; and
- WHEREAS:** On May 27, 2009, the Georgia Board of Natural Resources approved of and concurred in its Commissioner acting on behalf of that Board to request the transfer of custody and control of the premises to the custody and control of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources; and

WHEREAS: On June 18, 2009, the Georgia Department of Natural Resources requested transfer of custody and control of the premises to the custody and control of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY


ORDERED: That the custody of the above-described property (the premises) be and the same is hereby transferred from the Department of Administrative Services to the Georgia Department of Natural Resources.
