Georgia Emergency Management Agency – To provide funds to cover costs associated with the following declared disaster:

On March 27, severe weather began to affect the State of Georgia, causing torrential downpours and severe thunderstorms, resulting in flooding in the following counties: Atkinson, Baker, Ben Hill, Berrien, Brooks, Calhoun, Coffee, Colquitt, Decatur, Early, Lowndes, Miller, Mitchell, Tift, Turner, and Worth. Rivers continued to rise, overflowing their banks, and severe thunderstorms continued exacerbating downstream flooding in Appling, Bacon, Brantley, Clinch, Cook, Crisp, Dodge, Dougherty, Echols, Grady, Irwin, Jeff Davis, Lanier, Lee, McIntosh, Monroe, Montgomery, Pierce, Pulaski, Seminole, Tattnail, Telfair, Thomas, Toombs, Upson, Ware, Wayne, Wheeler, and Wilcox Counties.

The anticipated costs for disaster recovery for the declared counties is \$97,953,855. Of this, FEMA will contribute \$76,260,924 and local governments will provide \$6,149,657. The State will need to provide match in the amount of \$15,543,274. From FY09 funds, Governor's Emergency Funds of \$3,469,576 will be utilized. From FY10, Governor's Emergency Funds of \$3,469,576 which was appropriated for disasters will be used.

For FY10, a supplemental emergency fund request for the remaining match of \$8,604,032 will be recommended through the amended appropriation process.
