**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND GROUNDS
ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF**

- WHEREAS:** Georgia State Trooper First Class Chadwick LeCroy, #744 gave his life while fulfilling his duty to protect and serve his fellow Georgians; and
- WHEREAS:** Trooper First Class LeCroy was sworn in as a Georgia State Trooper on the 22nd of August 2008; and
- WHEREAS:** Trooper First Class LeCroy earned the "Top Gun" award while attending the Eighty-Fifth Georgia State Patrol Training School; and
- WHEREAS:** Trooper First Class LeCroy demonstrated the highest level of dedication and bravery and is survived by his wife, Keisha and sons, Bret and Chase; and
- WHEREAS:** Trooper First Class LeCroy's funeral service will be conducted at 1 p.m. Friday at Roswell Street Baptist Church, 774 Roswell Street in Marietta, with interment at the Kennesaw Memorial Park Cemetery.
