## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** There currently exists at 1400 Dean Forrest Road, Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia, two structures formerly used by the Georgia State Patrol and Department of Driver Services; and

**WHEREAS:** Custody of the above described structures along with 17 adjoining acres has been transferred to the Georgia Public Safety Training Center; and

**WHEREAS:** In the past, petroleum products have leached from underground storage tanks located on the above described property; and

**WHEREAS:** The Georgia Environmental Facilities Authority has funding available to remediate the contaminated property; and

**WHEREAS:** In order to properly remediate the contaminated site it is necessary to raze the above described structures; and

**WHEREAS:** The Army National Guard has agreed to raze the above described structures at no expense to the Georgia Public Safety Training Center.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That the Georgia Public Safety Training Center is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the structures from 1400 Dean Forrest Road, Savannah, Chatham County, Georgia.

**IT IS FURTHER**

**ORDERED:** That the appropriate staff of the Georgia Army National Guard, acting under the approval of the Georgia Public Safety Training Center, is hereby authorized to demolish the above described structures and to have all building materials removed from the premises; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
