EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

- WHEREAS:** The Honorable Tony Sellier was first sworn in as a member of the Georgia House of Representatives in 2007; and
- WHEREAS:** Representative Sellier served with distinction and faithfully represented the people of Georgia's 136th House District in the General Assembly; and
- WHEREAS:** Tony Sellier was a dedicated community servant and served as a volunteer to organizations such as the Fort Valley Kiwanis Club, the American Cancer Society, the Boys and Girls Clubs of Georgia Heartlands, his local Chambers of Commerce, and several other groups; and
- WHEREAS:** Representative Sellier was the epitome of living the American dream having been born in Trinidad, West Indies and raised in Venezuela. He came to America when he was 15 to study at a Catholic boarding school, went on to attend the University of West Florida where he received a BS Degree in Management and Economics, and in 1973 took his oath of United States citizenship.
