WHEREAS:

Gwinnett County Commissioner, Kevin R. Kenerly, was indicted on

October 11, 2010, on one count of Bribery and two counts of Disclosure of

Financial Interest; and

WHEREAS:

The indictment was transmitted to the Governor pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(b), and the certified copy was received on October 26, 2010; and

WHEREAS:

The 14-day period following the receipt of the indictment as prescribed by

O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(e) has passed.

Now, Therefore, By Virtue of the Authority Vested In Me As

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

**ORDERED:** 

That Attorney General Thurbert Baker; Commissioner Tim Lee of Cobb County; and Commissioner Charlie Laughinghouse of Forsyth County are hereby appointed as the review commission to determine whether the indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of the office of County Commissioner by Mr. Kenerly such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby and to make a written report to me within 14 days with a recommendation as to whether said commissioner should be suspended from office as required by O.C.G.A. §45-5-6(e).
