



# THE STATE OF GEORGIA

## EXECUTIVE ORDER

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BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** The General Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2010 (Act No. 345, 2009 Regular Session, H.B. 119) was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by the Governor on May 13, 2009, so as to make the following appropriations to the General Obligation Debt Sinking Fund (at items 397.501, 397.502, 397.503, 397.504, 397.505 and 397.506):

From State General Funds, \$220,190 is specifically appropriated for the purpose of financing projects and facilities for the Department of Human Services by means of the acquisition, construction, development, extension, enlargement, or improvement of land, waters, property, highways, buildings, structures, equipment or facilities, both real and personal, necessary or useful in connection therewith, through the issuance of not more than \$2,425,000 in principal amount of General Obligation Debt, the instruments of which shall have maturities not in excess of two hundred and forty months.

From State General Funds, \$137,108 is specifically appropriated for the purpose of financing projects and facilities for the Department of Human Services by means of the acquisition, construction, development, extension, enlargement, or improvement of land, waters, property, highways, buildings, structures, equipment or facilities, both real and personal, necessary or useful in connection therewith, through the issuance of not more than \$1,510,000 in principal amount of General Obligation Debt, the instruments of which shall have maturities not in excess of two hundred and forty months.

From State General Funds, \$74,002 is specifically appropriated for the purpose of financing projects and facilities for the Department of Human Services by means of the acquisition, construction, development, extension, enlargement, or improvement of land, waters, property, highways, buildings, structures, equipment or facilities, both real and personal, necessary or useful in connection therewith, through the issuance of not more than \$815,000 in principal amount of General Obligation Debt, the instruments of which shall have maturities not in excess of two hundred and forty months.

From State General Funds, \$324,156 is specifically appropriated for the purpose of financing projects and facilities for the Department of Human Services by means of the acquisition, construction, development, extension, enlargement, or improvement of land, waters, property, highways, buildings, structures, equipment or facilities, both real and personal, necessary or useful in connection therewith, through the issuance of not more than \$3,570,000 in principal amount of General Obligation Debt, the instruments of which shall have maturities not in excess of two hundred and forty months.

From State General Funds, \$93,040 is specifically appropriated for the purpose of financing projects and facilities for the Department of Human Services by means of the acquisition, construction, development, extension, enlargement, or improvement of land, waters, property, highways, buildings, structures, equipment or facilities, both real and personal, necessary or useful in connection therewith, through the issuance of not more than \$400,000 in principal amount of General Obligation Debt, the instruments of which shall have maturities not in excess of sixty months.

From State General Funds, \$32,688 is specifically appropriated for the purpose of financing projects and facilities for the Department of Human Services by means of the acquisition, construction, development, extension, enlargement, or improvement of land, waters, property, highways, buildings, structures, equipment or facilities, both real and personal, necessary or useful in connection therewith, through the issuance of not more than \$360,000 in principal amount of General Obligation Debt, the instruments of which shall have maturities not in excess of two hundred and forty months.

**WHEREAS:** During the 2009 Regular Session, the General Assembly passed H.B. 228, restructuring the Department of Human Resources; renaming the Department of Human Resources to the Department of Human Services, creating the new Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities; and

**WHEREAS:** The provisions of O.C.G.A. § 45-12-90 provide that in the event that any duties, purposes, and objects for which appropriations are made shall be transferred to a budget unit other than that to which appropriated, the appropriations for such duties, purposes, and objects shall be made available to such budget unit or budget units to which the duties, purposes, and objects are transferred; and

**WHEREAS:** Pursuant to the provisions of O.C.G.A. § 45-12-90 the Office of Planning and Budget is responsible for the disposition and transfer of such misdirected appropriations;


**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS EX OFFICIO DIRECTOR OF THE STATE BUDGET AND AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That the appropriation(s) set forth above are transferred from the Department of Human Services to the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities.

**IT IS FURTHER**

**ORDERED:** That this Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and that the Executive Counsel of the Governor shall place a public record of this Executive Order in the Executive Minutes.
