



THE STATE OF GEORGIA

EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

ORDERED: That in recognition of the state of Georgia's Spanish-speaking Citizenry, the Latino Commission for a New Georgia is established as a state commission.

ORDERED: That the Commission shall:

Serve as the advisory body to the Governor on matters relating to the Latino population of Georgia;

Work with the Latino population of Georgia, community leaders, private groups, and agencies of the state and local government for the purpose of serving and representing the Latino population of Georgia; and

Promote the coordination of programs and services of state, federal and local governments and private agencies, which affect the Latino population of Georgia.

ORDERED: That the Latino Commission for a New Georgia shall consist of members appointed by the Governor to serve at my pleasure.

Members of the Commission shall serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for actual expenses by the State in accordance with the standard state travel regulations. The Commission is administratively attached to the Office of Planning and Budget.

The Latino Commission for a New Georgia shall meet at the call of the Chairperson.
