



# THE STATE OF GEORGIA

## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

BY THE GOVERNOR:

ORDERED: That in recognition of the state of Georgia's Asian-American Citizenry, the Asian-American Commission for a New Georgia is established as a state commission.

ORDERED: That the Commission shall:

Serve as the advisory body to the Governor on matters relating to the Asian-American population of Georgia;

Work with the Asian American population of Georgia, community leaders, private groups, and agencies of the state and local government for the purpose of serving and representing the Asian-American population of Georgia; and

Promote the coordination of programs and services of state, federal and local governments and private agencies, which affect the Asian-American population of Georgia.

ORDERED: That the Asian-American Commission for a New Georgia shall consist of members appointed by the Governor.

Members of the Commission shall serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for actual expenses by the State in accordance with the standard state travel regulations. The Commission is administratively attached to the Office of Planning and Budget.

The Asian-American Commission for a New Georgia shall meet at the call of the Chairperson.
