EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: In March 2003, Nathan Rumph was found at 2471 Old National Pkwy. He had been shot once in the abdomen area. He was transported to the hospital but later died as a result of his injuries.

WHEREAS: Local Law Enforcement has interviewed family members, friends and witnesses that were in the area during the shooting, but have been unable to develop any suspects at this time.

WHEREAS: The family has provided local law enforcement with tips, but when attempts to verify the information are made, potential witnesses deny the information.

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that The Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of person or persons responsible for the murder of Nathan Rumph.
