EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS: The Honorable Thomas O. Marshall served with distinction as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Georgia from 1986 to 1990; and

WHEREAS: The Honorable Thomas O. Marshall served the citizens of Georgia further as a member of the Supreme Court of Georgia, a Judge of the Superior Courts of the Southwestern Judicial Circuit, and as a mediator, arbitrator, and practicing attorney in Atlanta, Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF THE HONORABLE CHIEF JUSTICE MARSHALL AND HIS FRIENDS AND FAMILY, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flags on all state buildings throughout the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the 13th day of June, 2003. On such day the flags shall be flown at half-staff until sunset.
