



# THE STATE OF GEORGIA

## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS**, there currently exists at Georgia Institute of Technology, Fulton County, Atlanta, Georgia buildings known as Callaway Apartments (Building No. 70) and Healey Apartment Building (Building No. 112)("the Buildings"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Regents at its meeting on November 19, 2002, declared by resolution that said Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by Georgia Institute of Technology or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed;

**WHEREAS**, it is the opinion of Ms. Linda M. Daniels, Vice Chancellor for Facilities of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, that the Buildings can no longer be advantageously used by Georgia Institute of Technology or the University System of Georgia and should be demolished and removed;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED**, that the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia is hereby authorized to demolish and remove the Buildings from Georgia Institute of Technology, Fulton County, Atlanta, Georgia;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED**, that the appropriate staff of Georgia Institute of Technology, Fulton County, Atlanta, Georgia, acting under the approval of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, is hereby authorized to demolish the Buildings and to have all building materials removed from the premises by

public works contract; all said demolition and removal to be performed as expeditiously as possible.
