EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On January 3, 2003, upon entering unit G-204 of the Palisades Club Apartments located at 2255 Satellite Blvd, Duluth, Georgia, Gwinnett County Police officers discovered the body of Secret Danette Marshall, who had been shot multiple times in the head.

WHEREAS The Gwinnett County Polices Department has exhausted all leads in the case, but has been unable to find the individual(s) responsible for this crime.

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that The Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Secret Danette Marshall.
