EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to and is in possession of approximately 0.351 of one acre of real property in Troup County, Georgia (the premises), as described in attached **EXHIBIT "A"**, now in the custody and control of the Georgia Forestry Commission; and
- WHEREAS:** The Georgia Department of Transportation is making certain improvements to State Route 1/U. S. 27 in Troup County; and
- WHEREAS:** The construction of the above mentioned improvements will require the permanent transfer of custody of the "Premises", as marked in yellow and described in **EXHIBIT "A"**, from the Georgia Forestry Commission to the Department of Transportation; and
- WHEREAS:** By letter dated August 15, 2003 the Right of Way Administrator for the Department of Transportation requested that custody of the "Premises" be transferred to the Department of Transportation; and
- WHEREAS:** By Resolution dated September 4, 2003 the Georgia Forestry Commissions requested that custody of the


"Premises" be transferred to the Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS: I have determined that it is in the best interest of the State of Georgia to transfer custody of 0.351 of one acre (marked in yellow) as described in **EXHIBIT "A"** from the Georgia Forestry Commission to the Department of Transportation

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY VIRTUE OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA ANNOTATED, §50-16-61, §50-16-144, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the custody of the above-described property be and the same is hereby transferred from the Georgia Forestry Commission to the Department of Transportation.
