EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On February 15, 2004 Scott Costillo was found murdered in his home.


WHEREAS: The Lincoln County Sheriff's Office along with the GBI have questioned several individuals in connection with the case, but have not been able to gather enough evidence to make an arrest

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Scott Costillo.
