EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS: Ronald Reagan served as the 40th President of the United States from 1981 to 1989 with great honor and distinction; and

WHEREAS: President Reagan's optimism and commitment to our founding principles restored faith in our country and renewed America's enduring spirit, boldly advanced the cause of freedom to every corner of the world, and led our nation's economy to one of the strongest periods of economic growth in U.S. history;

NOW THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF PRESIDENT RONALD REAGAN AND HIS FRIENDS AND FAMILY, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flags on all state buildings throughout the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff from this day, until sunset thirty days thereafter, July 4, 2004.
