EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: By Executive Order dated July 1, 2004 I appointed a committee to investigate Fulton County Sheriff Jacquelyn Barrett under O.C.G.A. § 15-16-26(a); and

WHEREAS: By letter dated July 21, 2004 that committee unanimously recommended that Sheriff Jacquelyn Barrett be suspended from office under the provisions of O.C.G.A. § 15-16-26(c); and

WHEREAS: By Executive Order dated July 23, 2004 I suspended Sheriff Barrett from office for sixty days, effective Monday, July 26, 2004 as provided in O.C.G.A. § 5-16-26(c); and

WHEREAS: The sixty-day period of suspension ends on Friday, September 24, 2004.

NOW THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Sheriff Jacquelyn Barrett's period of suspension be extended for an additional 30 days as provided in O.C.G.A. § 15-16-26(c).
