## **EXECUTIVE ORDER**

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS: On June 29, 2005 at 7:17 PM, Dinesh Shah was shot to death while working at the Ramada In, located at 3403 Memorial Drive.
- WHEREAS Dekalb County Police Department has been unable to generate any solid information leading to the identification or apprehension of a suspect;
- WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the individual/s responsible for the murder of Dinesh Shah.
