## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

### BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The Department of Natural Resources has requested permission to demolish and remove two 1960's – 1970's old brick homes, and 2 storage sheds and 2 bars of the same era, in addition to removing two old propane tanks and to fill in with dirt a 6" drilled well, location on the Macon Museum tract at Ocmulgee Heritage Greenway, Bibb County, Macon, Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Said structures have been declared by the Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources to be unserviceable and of no value to the Department; and

WHEREAS: The Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources has requested that said structures to be demolished and/or removed by Department personnel as soon as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA BY VIRTUE OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA, ANNOTATED 50-16-14, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Department of Natural Resources is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the demolition and disposal of aforesaid structures under terms and conditions which are in the best interest of the State of Georgia.
