EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to and the Department of Human Resources is the custodian of Northwest Georgia Regional Hospital in Floyd County; and

WHEREAS: One of the older structures on the Hospital campus is known as Building 206, said building being vacant and of no use in the operation of the Hospital; and

WHEREAS: Said building has inadequate heating, cooling and ventilation systems and does not meet Life Safety Fire Codes and Building; and

WHEREAS: The Department of Corrections has agreed to raze Building 206 using inmate labor at no cost to the Department of Human Resources; and

WHEREAS: By resolution dated March 16, 2005 the Board of Human Resources approved and recommended the complete razing and removal of Building 206.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE
AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF
THE STATE OF GEORGIA BY VIRTUE OF THE
OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA, ANNOTATED, 50-
16-61, 50-16-144, IT IS HEREBY**

ORDERED: That the Department of Human Resources is authorized to take such actions as necessary to effectuate the razing of the above described structures in accordance with applicable State laws and regulations.
