EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On April 23, 2005, Larry Bishop, Jr. an 18-year old Mundy's Mill

High School student was killed when gunfire erupted during a party

in Clayton County.

WHEREAS Clayton County Sheriff's Office has been unable to generate any solid

information leading to the identification or apprehension of a suspect;

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in

the State of Georgia.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED:

That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the individual/s responsible for the murder of Larry Bishop, Jr.
