## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On September 15, 2002, the badly burned bodies of Jeffrey Dennis Jackson and Shad Andrew English were found in the trunk of a vehicle that had been parked on Interstate I-20 and intentionally set on fire;

WHEREAS Although the Atlanta Police Department has identified a group of suspects, witnesses have been reluctant to cooperate;

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of Georgia;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the individual/s responsible for the murder of Jeffrey Dennis Jackson and Shad Andrew English.
