EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: By Executive Order dated May 12, 2005, I appointed a Commission to determine whether the indictment of Henry Mathis relates to and adversely impacts the administration of the office of city commissioner pursuant to O.C.G.A. §45-5-6; and

WHEREAS: By letter dated, May 20, 2005 that committee unanimously recommended that Albany City Commissioner Henry Mathis be suspended from office under the provisions of O.C.G.A. §45-5-6(c).

NOW THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF , IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Commissioner Henry Mathis is hereby suspended from office immediately and without further action pending the final disposition of the case or until the expiration of his term of office, whichever occurs first as provided in O.C.G.A. §45-5-6(c).

IT IS FURTHER

ORDERED: That Dorothy Brown Hubbard is appointed, effective immediately, to fill the temporary vacancy in the office of Ward 2 City Commissioner of the City of Albany pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(d)(1).
