EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to and the Department of Juvenile Justice is the custodian of 8.702 acres of real property located on Beaverdam Road in Clarke County as described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof; and
- WHEREAS:** Said property was formerly the site of the Athens Regional Youth Detention Center; and
- WHEREAS:** The Department of Juvenile Justice has ceased to operate the Athens Regional Youth Detention Center and have moved detainees to other facilities; and
- WHEREAS:** By Resolution dated April 28, 2005 the Department of Juvenile Justice declared the subject property surplus to their needs; and
- WHEREAS:** The Department of Public Safety is desirous of using the subject property as the site of the Northeast Georgia Regional Police Academy; and
- WHEREAS:** By Resolution dated April 13, 2005 the Board of Public Safety requested that custody of the above-described property be transferred to the Department of Public Safety for use as a Regional Police Academy.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE
AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF
THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

ORDERED:

That the custody of the above-described property be and the same is hereby transferred from the Department of Juvenile Justice to the Department of Public Safety.
