EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia holds title to and is in possession of approximately 53 square feet of real property in Fulton County, Georgia (the premises), as described in attached EXHIBIT "A", now in the custody and control of the State Properties Commission; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Department of Transportation is replacing the Peachtree Street bridge as it passes over the Western and Atlantic Railroad right of way; and

WHEREAS: The replacement of the above mentioned bridge will require the permanent transfer of custody of the "Premises", from the State Properties Commission; and

WHEREAS: The State Properties Commission at its meeting of August 24, 2005, approved the transfer of the above described property to the Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS: I have determined that it is in the best interest of the State of Georgia to transfer custody of approximately 53 square feet as described in EXHIBIT "A" from the State Properties Commission to the Department of Transportation;

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY O.C.G.A. § 50-16-61, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the custody of the above-described property be and the same is hereby transferred from the State Properties Commission to the Department of Transportation.
