EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On June 20, 2006, Mr. Woo Chong was severly beaten during an

apparent robbery in his place of business at 3815 North Druid Hills Rd.,

in Dekalb County and later died from his injuries; and

WHEREAS: The Dekalb County Police Department has conducted an investigation and

has been unable to generate any solid leads; and

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotation provides that

the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of a person who has

committed a felony.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN

ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby offered for information

leading to the identification, arrest and conviction of the individual/s

responsible for the murder of Mr. Chong Woo
