EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On March 24, 2007, Ms. Theresa Parker was reported missing.

WHEREAS: The Walker County Sheriff's Office, along with The Georgia Bureau of Investigation have aggressively investigated this case and have been unable to generate any solid leads.

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of a person who has committed a felony.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00, is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, arrest and conviction of the individual/s responsible for the disappearance of Theresa Parker.
