WHEREAS: Fulton County has filed an appeal in the matter of *State of Georgia*

v. Brian Gene Nichols, Case Number 2005SC29988, relating to the issue of whether the trial court erred in ordering Fulton County to pay certain expenses in the defense of Mr. Brian Gene Nichols

where the death penalty is being sought; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Public Defender Standards Council is the Appellee in

WHEREAS: The Attorney General, because of a conflict, has declined
