BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS:

The citizens of the United States mourn the death of former first

lady, Lady Bird Johnson; and

WHEREAS:

Mrs. Johnson was an environmentalist who worked to create a more beautiful America, and through her national campaign for beautification, became the inspiration for The Highway

Beautification Act of 1965.

Now, therefore, in honor and as a mark of respect for the memory of Claudia Alta "Lady Bird" Johnson, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of

THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED:

That in conjunction with the Proclamation of the President of the United States of America, the flag of the United States and the flag of this state shall be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds on Sunday, July 15, 2007, the day of her funeral, until sunset.
