EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On August 7, 2007, Mr. Robbie Crankshaw was shot and killed near his place of employment (Jackson Auto), in Mableton, Georgia; and

WHEREAS: The Cobb County Sheriff's Office has conducted an investigation and has unable to generate any leads; and

WHEREAS: Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer, and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of a person who has committed a felony.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That a reward in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the individual/s responsible for the murder of Robbie Crankshaw.
